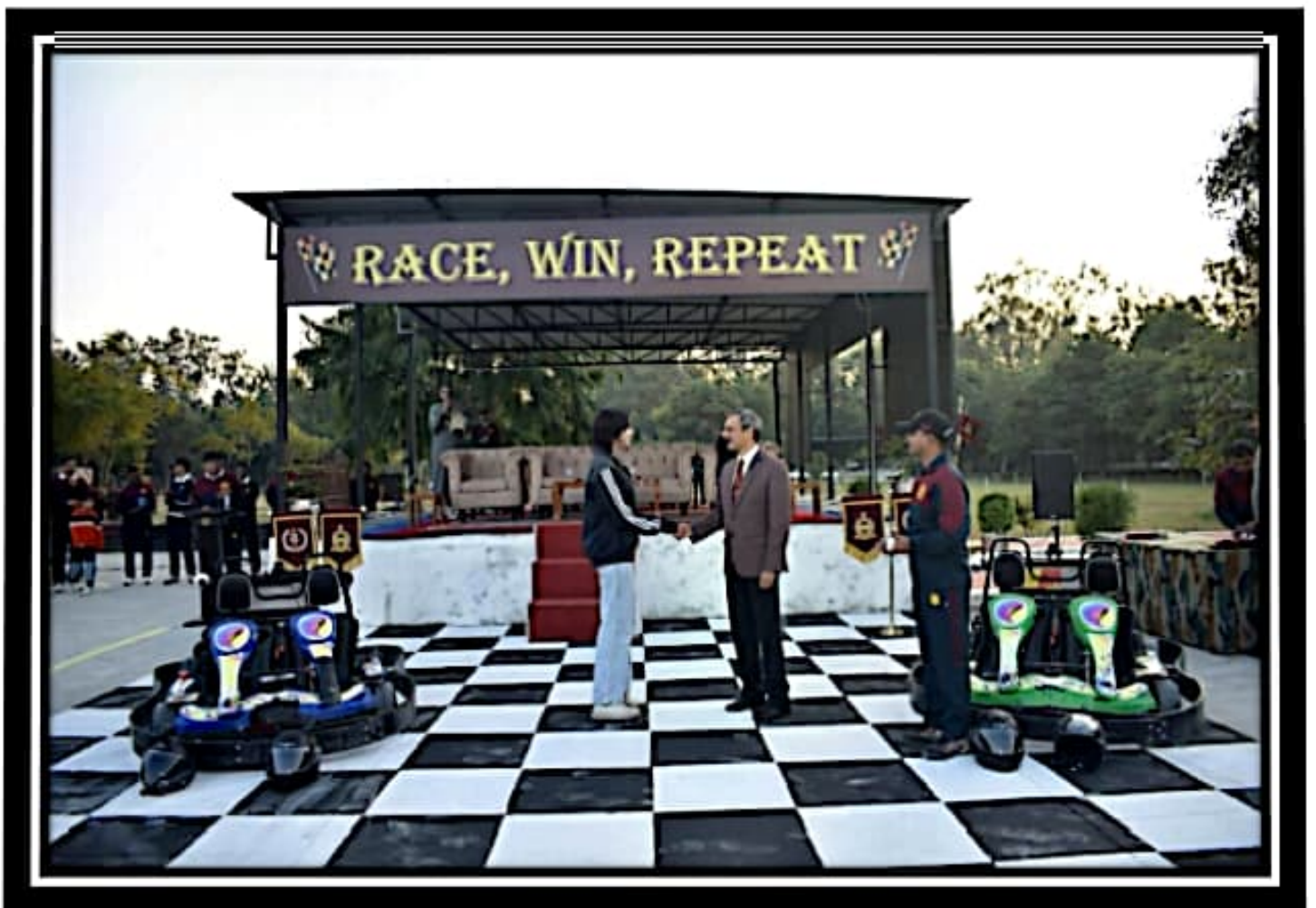
### STUDENT EXCELS IN GO-KARTING COMPETITION
