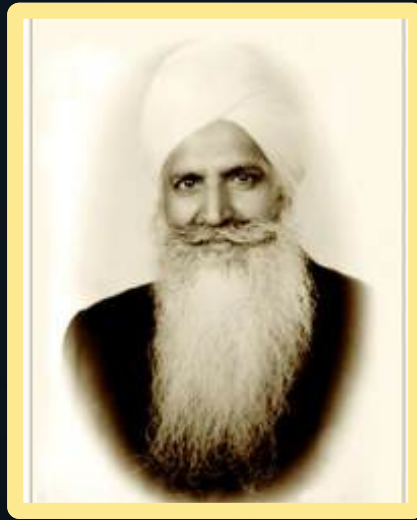

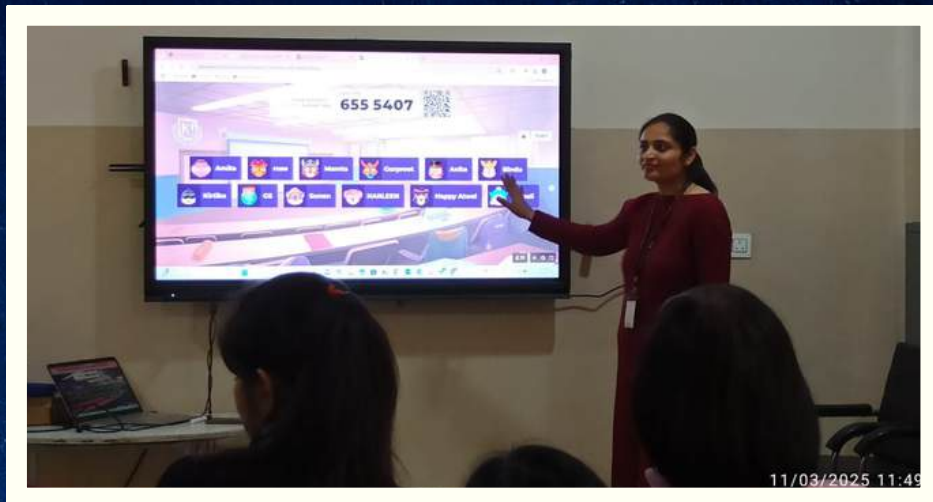

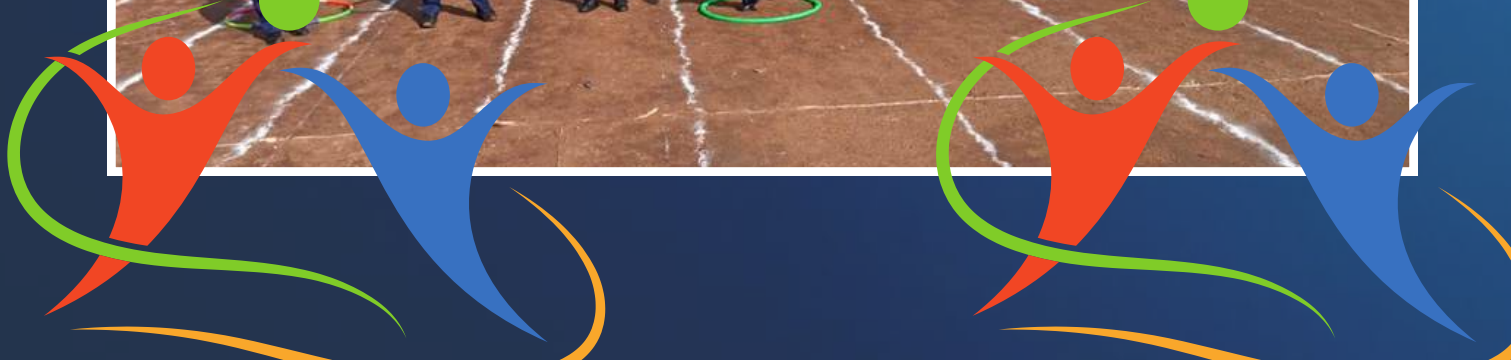
Workshop on AI Conducted at GNFG School

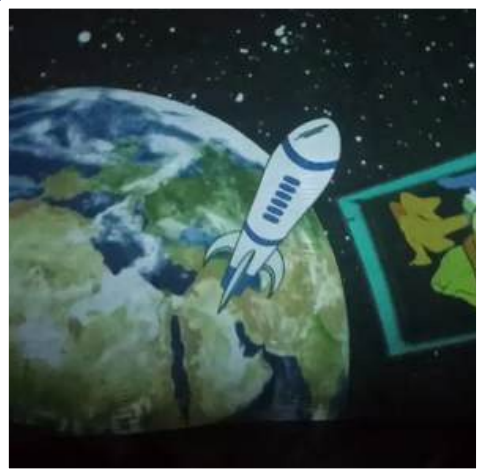


Republic Day Fancy Dress Competition at GNFG School

Kindergarten tots of Gurunanak foundation global school embraced the spirit of Holi through a vibrant celebration.

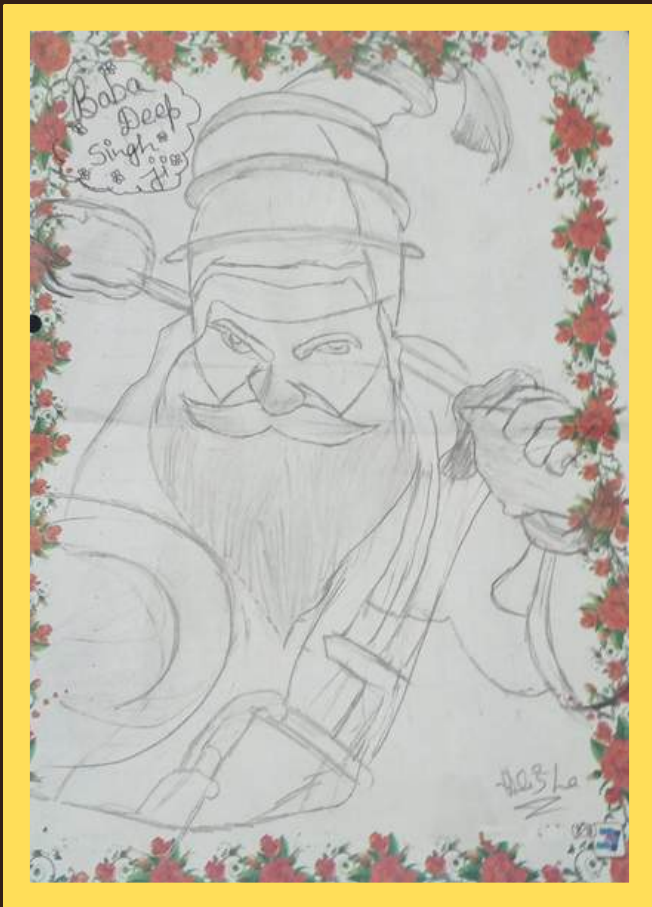
The school premises was adorned with colorful banners, streamers, and rangoli designs to create a festive ambiance.

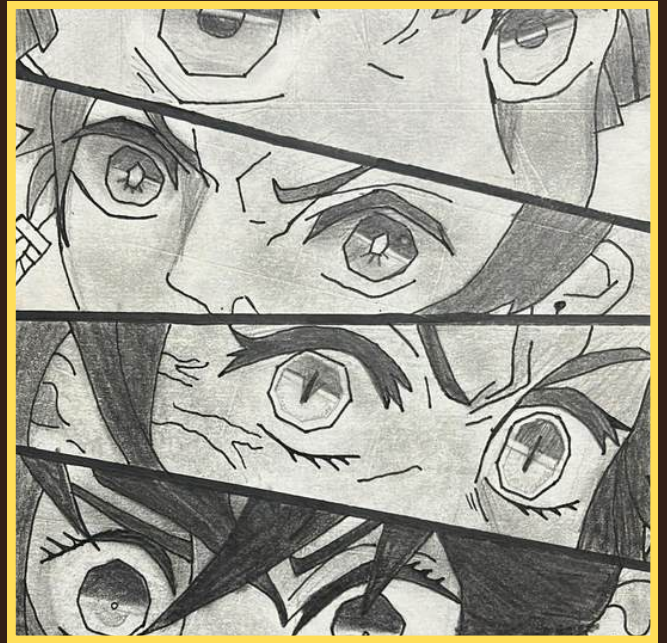

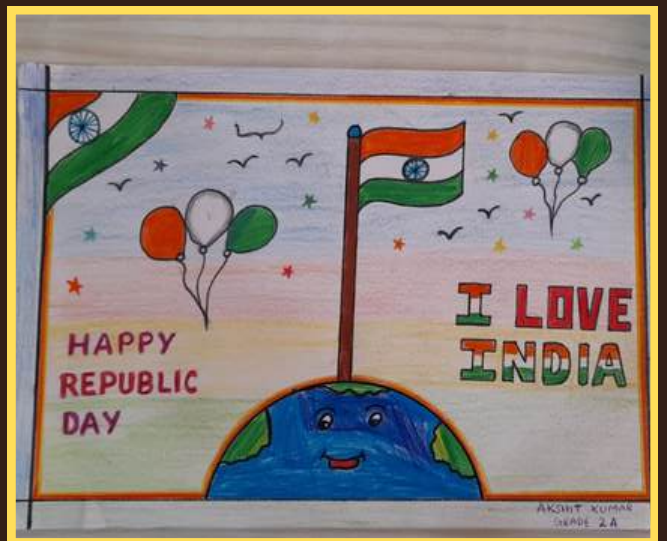

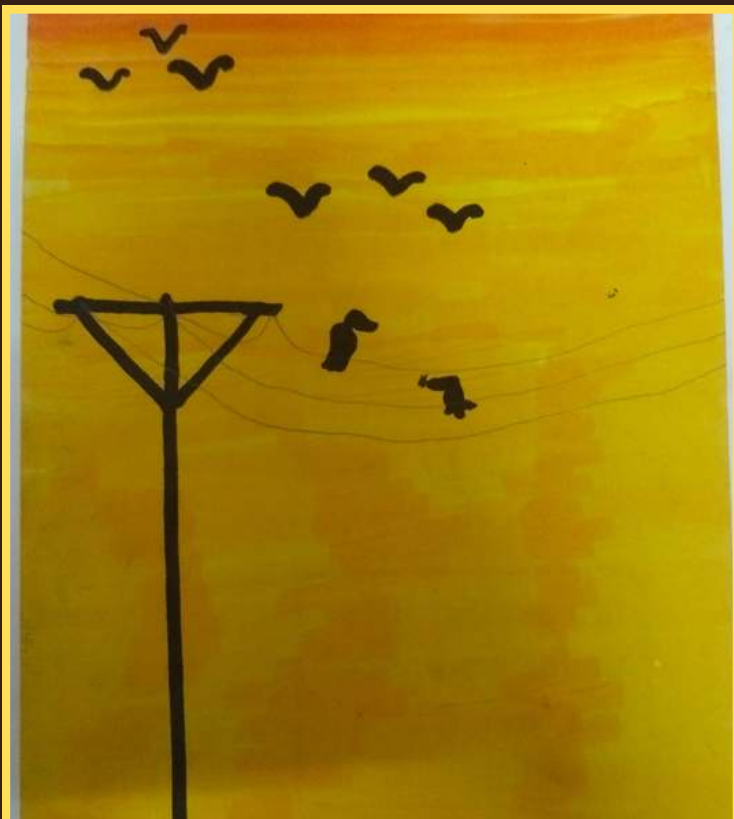
